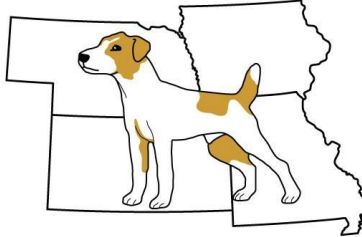

JRTCA General Rules for Exhibitors

1. All sanctioned classes are open to Jack Russell Terriers only.
2. Exhibitors and owners of terriers entered must be current JRTCA members and must not be a member of a conflicting JRT organization or register their JRTs in any all-breed registry or conflicting JRT organization. If an exhibitor is found to be in violation of this policy, entry will be disqualified, and no refunds will be given. If a violation is confirmed after the trial, placements will be voided from all JRTCA records. Exhibitors must submit a completed entry form including a signed waiver for every trial they enter.
3. Entries MUST be within the 10-15" JRTCA height standard for all sanctioned classes (with the exception of pups who have not yet met the 10" height standard); measuring devices will be available on the trial grounds.
4. Puppies (under 12 months) are not eligible for championship in any division but their own. Puppies are eligible to compete only if they have reached their four-month birthday (not 16 weeks). A puppy's age is the actual age the pup is on the day of the trial.
5. Bitches in season may not compete in any division. Pre-entry fees of bitches in season will be refunded with a veterinarian certificate, or as otherwise agreed upon by the Trial Chairperson.
6. Spayed or neutered terriers may compete in working and Miscellaneous Conformation. They may not compete in Puppy, Family*, Open Conformation.
*Note: For Family Classes, Brood Bitches and Stud Dogs entered may not be spayed/neutered. The offspring at their sides may be intact or spayed/neutered.
7. A terrier bred by a sanctioned JRTCA Judge may not be shown under that Judge in the conformation division.
8. Terriers owned or co-owned by the Trial Chairperson, or any member of their household, may not be entered in any phase of the competition, with the exception of Child and Youth Handling.
9. Terriers owned by judges may not be entered in the division or section in which they are judging but may enter the competition in any other division.
10. Terriers owned by stewards may be entered in any division if they find a substitute to perform their duties or have someone else show their terriers.
11. Requests for the measurement of a terrier entered in any class number may be made only by another exhibitor in that same class number or by the Judge EXCEPT in Racing. Requests for the measurement of a terrier in Racing may be made by the Judge or by an exhibitor with a terrier entered in the same class number; OR, if classes are split by gender, may call for the measurement of a terrier of the opposite gender in the same age and height category. (Example: The owner of an under adult dog entered in Racing may call for the measurement of an under adult bitch as the potential exists for them to race each other in the Championship Races.) Exhibitors racing puppies may call for the measurement of a puppy in a different age category as long as it is in the same height category. The person making the request for measurement must name the terrier or terriers they wish to have measured, but requests for measurement of entire classes will not be honored. The measurement of the terrier will be considered the terrier's official height for the duration of the trial. Only JRTCA height cards issued after September 1999 will be honored.
12. Excessive use of squeaky or fur-like baiting devices by exhibitors is prohibited in the Conformation ring and may result in the exhibitor being excused from the class. "Excessive use" will be at Judge's discretion.
13. Exhibitors participating in the JRTCA Working Terrier classes, or Certificate Go-To-Ground and Super Earth must submit the appropriate JRTCA certificates with pre-entries or at the time of post-entry. The Judge may require a copy of the certificate be presented to the Ring/Den steward at time of judging. Registered terriers may submit a copy of NHC application signed by a JRTCA Working Judge within 30 days of the date it was issued.

14. Puppies under the age of three months are not permitted on the trial grounds. Any person violating this rule will be excused from all classes entered and asked to leave the trial site. (This applies to RV's and Campers, if at the same address as the trial grounds).
15. All dogs must be leashed or crated except when competition requires off-leash work. No liberty leashes allowed.
16. Overly aggressive dogs, or an owner's failure to control their dog, may result in disqualification at the discretion of the Judges or the Trial Chairperson.
17. The abuse or severe disciplining of dogs on the trial grounds is prohibited. Anyone displaying such behavior will be asked to leave the trial site, and no entry fees will be refunded.
18. Dogs other than JRTs on the grounds may be excluded or permitted at the discretion of the Trial Chairperson.
19. Exhibitors are responsible to double check the classes they have entered and be on time. No refunds will be given for missed classes.
20. The owner/handler of a terrier entering any class does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by the rules of the JRTCA and the trial. A copy of the JRTCA Rule Book can be obtained by contacting the JRTCA office (410-561-3655) or it can be downloaded from the JRTCA website (www.therealjackrussell.com).
21. Unsportsmanlike conduct, or the use of foul and abusive language, will not be tolerated. Anyone demonstrating such conduct will be asked to leave the trial site and no entry fees will be refunded. In addition, such conduct will be subject to penalties which may include the suspension of membership, restriction from entering the JRTCA National Trial, and/or fines. Trial Chairpersons have the right to refuse any entry at their sole and absolute discretion.
22. All dogs brought to JRTCA sanctioned trials must be current on vaccinations. No dogs of any age may be brought to a trial who have suspicion of contagious or infectious disease. Proof of vaccinations should be made available upon request.
23. Judges must not eat, smoke, vape or use cell phones while judging their events.
24. **THE JUDGE'S DECISION IS FINAL IN ALL DIVISIONS. All JRTCA Rules must be followed.**

This does not apply to puppies under 12 months old. Non-Sanctioned classes do not have a per dog fee.

We will not pay the Transaction fees, that is your responsibility.

Every effort will be made to start trial events on time. **Dogs late to racing or conformation will be scratched. NO REFUNDS for missed classes.**

- REFUNDS for classes will be given ONLY in cases of accident or illness of a terrier or owner, or for bitches in season. Situations must be documented in writing. Refunds provided by mail within 14 days following the trial.
- **ENTRIES must be postmarked by June 8, 2026. Trial Vault June 15, 2026** Entries postmarked after that date will be considered post entries and charged accordingly. Please pre-enter for the trial, this helps the trial run smoother and is cheaper for you. No phone entries, please.
- CLASSES may be combined if insufficient entries are received.
- CROSS ENTERING is not permitted within the Open Section of the Conformation Division. Also, terriers may not enter both the Open and Working sections.
- RIBBONS 1st to 6th
- **RAFFLE – Please support the raffle by donating at least one raffle prize.**
- VENDORS – No fee is required; however, vendors are required to furnish a nice raffle prize. Please support the vendors.
- **No Alcoholic Beverages allowed in the Park**
- **Clean up after your dogs Where Ever you GO!**
- No Post Entries for the JRTCA racing
- Colored Terrier owners DO NOT have to be members of the JRTCA to compete.
- All payments must be in US currency, US Banks.

Saturday & Sunday

Races

1. **SAFETY FIRST: ALL TERRIERS MUST BE MUZZLED!** Plastic muzzle or close-ended cloth muzzles only. No figure eight or open-ended muzzles will be allowed. Black, brown, clear, or white muzzles are acceptable. No colored basket or softie muzzles are allowed.

2. **Good sportsmanship is encouraged and expected. Poor sportsmanship will not be tolerated.**

3. QUALIFICATIONS FOR CHAMPIONSHIP RUN OFFS

A. A terrier MUST ENTER AND FINISH in both, at least one flat race AND one hurdle race at the beginning level based on trial entries (heat, semi, final),

B. A FINISHED race is when the terrier runs down the track unassisted (by owner or anyone else) with a secured muzzle to the backside of the barrier.

C. Terrier must place first in a flat or hurdle final to qualify for championship run offs. First to the hole is not necessarily first thru the backside of the barrier.

D. In the event a terrier does not meet all the above criteria, the second place terrier in the final of that class (either flats or hurdles) will qualify for the championship run off if they meet the criteria as outlined above.

4. GENERAL RACING PROCESS

A. Exhibitors must have entries ready to race, be aware of their classes, and be ready when called. In the event a heat is missed, permission to run in a later heat is granted at the discretion of the racing judge or steward. There are no refunds for missed classes.

B. Once entries are loaded into the starting box, all handlers shall proceed to the finish line/catch area and be ready to receive their terriers. No one may enter the racetrack during a race to assist a terrier across the finish line, any violation of this would result in the terrier being assisted disqualified from the race and thus not considered as finishing that race. If a terrier has not completed the race **-AND IS CONSIDERED TO BE NEW (NEWBIE) AT RACING, IT IS AT THE JUDGES DISCRETION TO ALLOW THE HANDLER TO ASSIST THE TERRIER TO FINISH THE RACE. PLACEMENT, IF ANY, IS THE JUDGES DECISION. THIS DOES NOT PERTAIN TO THE PUPPY CLASSES.**

C. Puppy and Senior hurdles must be run over LOW hurdles

D. Adult terriers MAY NOT CROSS ENTER between Adult, Veteran and Senior Racing classes

E. Once the Racing Division has started, NO requests for height measurement will be honored. Any pre-race height request must be completed by a current standing Conformation judge.

5. RERUNS

A. **In the event of a lure malfunction** that alters the forward motion of the race the race will be rerun (lure is caught by a terrier, lure stops, lure gets caught on a hurdle, lure flies off the track)

B. **At the discretion of the racing judge for any reason**

6. DISQUALIFICATION

A. In a flat or hurdle race, any entry going around the jumps or jumping out of the racetrack or not wearing a secured muzzle will be disqualified from the race and therefore shown as not finishing that race.

B. Any terrier engaged in fighting shall be disqualified by the Racing Judge from any further racing during the trial. No refund will be given.

7. CATCH PEN ETIQUETTE

A. No smoking / vaping is allowed in the catch pen or start area

B. No cell phone calls accepted or made in the catch pen

Flat Veteran Races

- Class 14:** Veteran dogs, 6 years and older, 10 up to 12.5"
- Class 15:** Veteran dogs, 6 years and older, over 12.5" up to 15".
- Class 16:** Veteran bitches, 6 years and older, 10 up to 12.5"
- Class 17:** Veteran bitches, 6 years and older, over 12.5" up to 15".

Flat Other Terrier Races

- Class 18:** Other Terrier, 1 year and older, Under 12.5" (Non-Sanctioned)
Open to all breeds. Dog and bitches over 1 year of age.
- Class 19:** Other Terrier, 1 year and older, Over 12.5" (Non-Sanctioned)
Open to all breeds. Dog and bitches over 1 year of age.

Steeplechase Puppy Races

- Class 20:** Pups, 6 up to 9 months, up to 12.5"
- Class 21:** Pups, 6 up to 9 months, over 12.5" up to 15"
- Class 22:** Pups, 9 up to 12 months, up to 12.5"
- Class 23:** Pups, 9 up to 12 months, over 12.5" up to 15"

Steeplechase Senior Races

- Class 24:** Senior dogs, 9 years and older, 10 up to 12.5"
- Class 25:** Senior dogs, 9 years and older, over 12.5" up to 15"
- Class 26:** Senior bitches, 9 years and older, 10 up to 12.5".
- Class 27:** Senior bitches, 9 years and older, over 12.5" up to 15"

Puppy Racing Finals

- Class 28:** PUPPY RACING CHAMPION & RESERVE UP TO 12.5".
Open to 1st place winners of up to 12.5" puppy classes 2, 4, 20, 22 .
No entry fee.
- Class 29:** PUPPY RACING CHAMPION & RESERVE OVER 12.5" UP TO 15".
Open to 1st place winners of 12.5 up to 15" puppy classes 3, 5, 21, 23.
No entry fee.

Senior Racing Finals

- Class 30:** SENIOR RACING CHAMPION & RESERVE 10 UP TO 12.5".
Open to 1st place winners of 10 up to 12.5" senior classes 6, 8, 24, 26. No entry fee.
- Class 31:** SENIOR RACING CHAMPION & RESERVE OVER 12.5" UP TO 15".
Open to 1st place winners of 12.5 up to 15" senior classes 7, 9, 25, 27. No entry fee.

Steeplechase Adult Races

- Class 32:** Dogs, 1 year and older, 10 up to 12.5".
- Class 33:** Dogs, 1 year and older, over 12.5" up to 15".
- Class 34:** Bitches, 1 year and older, 10 up to 12.5".
- Class 35:** Bitches, 1 year and older, over 12.5" up to 15".

Steeplechase Veteran Races

- Class 36:** Veteran dogs, 6 years and older, 10 up to 12.5".
- Class 37:** Veteran dogs, 6 years and older, over 12.5" up to 15".
- Class 38:** Veteran bitches, 6 years and older, 10 up to 12.5".
- Class 39:** Veteran bitches, 6 years and older, over 12.5" up to 15".

- Class 40:** ADULT RACING CHAMPION & RESERVE 10 UP TO 12.5".
Open to 1st place winners of 10 up to 12.5" adult classes 10, 12, 32, 34. No entry fee.
- Class 41:** ADULT RACING CHAMPION & RESERVE OVER 12.5" UP TO 15".
Open to 1st place winners of 12.5 up to 15" adult classes 11, 13, 33, 35. No entry fee.

Veteran Racing Finals

- Class 42:** VETERANS RACING CHAMPION & RESERVE 10 UP TO 12.5".
Open to 1st place winners of 10 up to 12.5" veteran classes 14, 16, 36, 38. No entry fee.
- Class 43:** VETERANS RACING CHAMPION & RESERVE OVER 12.5" UP TO 15".
Open to 1st place winners of 12.5 up to 15" veteran classes 15, 17, 37, 39. No entry fee.

Steeplechase Other-Terrier Races(Non-Sanctioned)

- Class 44:** Other Terrier Under 12.5" (Non-Sanctioned)
Open to all breeds. Dog and bitches over 1 year of age.

Youth Division Class List

The sanctioned Youth Division is open to JRTCA child and/or youth members in the following age brackets: Child Handler (ages 5 thru 9) and Youth Handler (ages 10 thru 16). **A child/youth exhibitor's age is determined as of January 1st of the current calendar year except for those children turning five years of age. They may begin competing in Child Handler any time following their fifth birthday.**

2. All exhibitors in the Youth Division must be current JRTCA members, either under a Family membership or under an individual Youth membership.
3. Youths or their families applying for a JRTCA membership at a Sanctioned Trial will be allowed to enter classes at that trial.
4. Child Handlers may handle an adult terrier or a 6-12 month old terrier. Youth Handlers may only handle an adult terrier.
5. Except in the case of an injured or ill terrier (Refer to Rule 6), Youth Handlers must handle the **SAME** terrier, which must be an **ADULT** terrier, in all Youth Handler classes. No puppies are permitted in any Youth Handler classes.
6. In the rare instance that a Youth Handler's dog is injured or medically unable to continue in any remaining events at a given trial, the youth may continue to compete with another dog. In this case, the following procedure is to be followed: • Prior to any terrier substitution, the Youth Handler must notify the Trial Chairperson. The Trial Chairperson must see and evaluate the terrier.

- The youth may use another **ADULT** terrier, which must be the **SAME ADULT** terrier (no puppies allowed) used for the remaining Youth Division events.

- Only one terrier substitution may be made, per handler, for each trial. (In the case of the JRTCA National Trial, the three day format equals one trial.)

- All placement points earned by the handler prior to the substitution will remain in place. No placement points will be earned by the handler following the substitution.

Note: An injured or ill terrier should be attended to as soon as possible. A licensed Veterinarian or technician should be consulted at the trial site if available.

7. Terriers owned or co-owned by the judge of any Youth Division classes are not eligible. Terriers owned or co-owned by the Trial Chairperson, or any member of their household may be entered in the Youth Division.

8. Spayed or neutered terriers may be exhibited in the Youth Division.

9. Terriers competing in Youth GTG, if entered in regular GTG classes, must compete in the regular GTG class prior to competing in the Youth GTG class. Terriers competing in Youth Agility, as well as regular Agility, must compete in the class order upon which the judge decides. It is important to inform the judge that the terrier is competing in Youth Handler as well as regular classes.

10. The Sanctioned Youth Division consists of the following classes:

Child Handler - In the Conformation ring (may not be combined with Youth Handler).

Youth Handler - In the Conformation ring (may not be combined with Child Handler).

Class 48: Child handler

Open to any youth aged 5 through 9, handling a Jack Russell Terrier, six months of age or older. This class is offered as an introductory experience in handling and learning about the Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on child's ability to present his/her dog and beginning knowledge of the Jack Russell. Quality of the dog NOT to be considered

Class 49: Child Go-to-Ground

Open to any child aged 5 through 9, handling 6 month of age or older Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the child's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of Go-To-Ground. To be run through the 10-foot Novice tunnel; time not to be considered. If the terrier is competing in a regular GTG class, it needs to run in the regular GTG class before It can compete in Child Go-To-Ground. (Non-Sanctioned).

Class 50: CHILD HANDLER HIGH SCORE & RESERVE

Awarded to the highest scoring Child and runner-up in classes 48-49. The points are awarded as follows: 1st = 8 points; 2nd = 6 points; 3rd = 5 points; 4th = 4 points; 5th place = 3 points, 6th place = 2 points, and participation = 1 point. (Non-Sanctioned, No entry fee).

- Class 51: Youth handler**
Open to any youth aged 10 through 16, handling an adult (1 year or older) Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the youth's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of the Jack Russell Terrier. Quality of the dog NOT to be considered.
- Class 52: Youth Working Judge's Choice**
Open to any youth handler aged 10 through 16. Judged on the youths knowledge of hunting and the working terrier, and ability to answer questions presented by a JRTCA Working Judge; no terrier to accompany handler in class.
- Class 53: Youth Handler Go-to-Ground**
Open to any youth aged 10 through 16, handling an adult (1 year or older) Jack Russell Terrier. Judges on Youth's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of GTG. To be run through 10 foot novice liner. Time not to be considered. If terrier is competing in a regular GTG class, it needs to run in regular GTG class before it can compete in Youth GTG.
- Class 54: YOUTH HANDLER HIGH SCORE & RESERVE**
Awarded to highest scoring youth and runner up in class 51, 52, and 53. The points are awarded as follows:
8 points = 1st place, 6 points = 2nd place, 5 points = 3rd place, 4 points = 4th place, 3 points = 5th place, 2 points = 6th place, 1 point = Participation
Youth exhibitors must complete a minimum of youth conformation and GTG to qualify for the youth handler high score and reserve. In the case of a tie, it will be broken by a handling class to be held in the conformation ring, judge to be decided by trial chairperson.

Conformation

All terriers are judged on the JRTCA breed standard, except Child/Youth handlers where conformation is not considered and judging is based on the handler's ability. All terriers must be exhibited on lead. Cross-entering is not permitted between the Open Section and the Working Section. JRTCA Working Conformation is open to any JRTCA-registered terrier owned by a JRTCA member which holds a JRTCA Natural Hunting Certificate (NHC). A copy of the NHC certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or presented in the ring at time of judging.

Working Terrier Conformation

Open to any JRTCA registered terrier owned by a JRTCA member which holds a JRTCA Natural Hunting Certificate. Terriers entering the Working Section may not cross-enter into the Open Section; no cross-entering is permitted within the Working Section.

- Class 55: Bronze medallion dog**
Open to any dog, which has earned the JRTCA Bronze Medallion for Special Merit in the Field.
- Class 56: Working terrier dog, 10 up to 12.5"**
- Class 57: Working terrier dog, over 12.5 up to 15"**
- Class 58: Neutered Working terrier dog,**
Open to any adult Jack Russell Terrier, which holds a JRTCA Natural Hunting Certificate
- Class 59: BEST WORKING TERRIER DOG & RESERVE**
Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of working terrier dog classes 55 through 58 No entry fee.
- Class 60: Bronze medallion bitch**
Open to any bitch, which has earned the JRTCA Bronze Medallion for Special Merit in the field.
- Class 61: Working terrier bitch, 10 up to 12.5",**
- Class 62: Working terrier bitch, over 12.5 up to 15",**
- Class 63: Spay Working terrier bitch**
Open to any adult Jack Russell Terrier, which holds a JRTCA Natural Hunting Certificate
- Class 64: BEST WORKING TERRIER BITCH & RESERVE**
Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of Working Terrier Bitch classes 60 through 63.

Class 65: WORKING TERRIER CHAMPION & RESERVE

Open to 1st and 2nd place winners from Best/Reserve Best Working Dog class 59 and Best/Reserve Best Working Bitch class 64. No entry fee.

Miscellaneous Conformation

Open to Best/Reserve Best Open Dog; Best/Reserve Best Open Bitch Class: 95,99; No Entry Fee

Class 101: **BEST OF THE BEST & RESERVE (Non-Sanctioned)** No Entry Fee

Open to Champion /Reserve Champion Working Terrier, Best/ Reserve Open Terrier, Best/ Reserve Neuter/Spay Terrier, Best / Reserve Veteran Terrier, Best / Reserve Other Terrier, 6 to 12 month Puppy Champion/Reserve, Best/Reserve Suitability, Best/Reserve Family (no get or produce)

Go-To-Ground Rules

1. Sanctioned Go-to-Ground is open to puppies, 4 to 12 months of age, and adults. Certificate Go-to Ground classes are open to adult terriers which have earned and received a JRTCA Go-to-Ground Certificate.
2. Schooling prior to the competition is NOT permitted. Any violation of this rule shall result in disqualification from the Go-To-Ground competition at this trial. No entry fees will be refunded.
3. Exhibitors in Open or Puppy classes are expected to pick up score sheets for their terriers at the Secretary's stand for classes in which score sheets are used. At the time of the competition, the exhibitor will give the score sheet to the Den Steward for scoring by the Judge.
4. Exhibitors are encouraged to read the score sheets for classes in which score sheets are provided and class descriptions carefully, and review and abide by the JRTCA Rules for Go-To-Ground.
5. A line approximately two feet from the entrance hole will be designated as the starting line. Time starts when the terrier crosses the starting line. The terrier is to be released so that all four of the terrier's feet are on the ground before crossing the starting line. Any violation of this rule, accidental or intentional, shall result in disqualification of the terrier from the class in which the violation occurs. No entry fees will be refunded.
6. The Judge signals the release of the terrier. Do not release your terrier until the Judge signals. Any violation of this rule, accidental or intentional, shall result in disqualification of the terrier from the class in which the violation occurs. No entry fee will be refunded.
7. After the terrier is released, the handler shall remain at the starting line. Touching the terrier after release, before entering the tunnel, shall result in disqualification of the terrier from the class. Once the terrier has entered, the handler may not block the entrance hole by standing in it or in any other manner. Commands and encouragement may be given. The Judge will signal to the exhibitor to pick up the terrier at the completion of their work.
8. Terriers, puppies, and adults registered or non-registered, which have previously scored 100% in the Novice Class at a JRTCA trial may not, under any circumstances, compete in these classes again, at any JRTCA Sanctioned Trial.
9. Puppies, 6 to 12 months who have earned 100% in the Open Puppy Class at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee enter the Puppy Championship class at this trial OR may continue competing in Open Puppy Go to Ground class at future trials. Winners of the Puppy Championship Go to Ground class will determine the Puppy GTG Champion & Reserve. Open Puppy GTG is not open to any Puppy which has competed in Puppy Championship GTG. (01/22)
10. Terriers, 1 year old or older, registered, or non-registered, which have previously scored 100% in the Open Class, may continue to compete in the Open Adult Class until they receive their Trial Certificate. A terrier achieving 100% in the Open Adult Class is eligible to apply for a Trial Certificate when the terrier is registered or recorded with the JRTCA. No adult terrier may compete in the Championship Certificate class until the Trial Certificate has been applied for and issued.
11. To obtain a Trial Certificate after scoring 100% in an Open Class at a JRTCA Sanctioned Trial, the owner of the adult terrier shall submit a copy of the qualifying score sheet, signed and initialed by the GTG judge, along with a \$35.00 filing fee, to the JRTCA office. The score sheet is good for the life of the dog and may be submitted with the registration application if the terrier is not already registered/recorded with the JRTCA.
12. Once a terrier has received their Trial Certificate, they MUST compete in the Certificate Class and cannot go back into Open. CROSS-ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN CERTIFICATE CLASSES.
13. In the event of a tie, the tie shall be broken by a run-off; the best time shall determine the winner.
14. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to collect the score sheet or card if provided after the judging is complete.
15. Copies of JRTCA Trial Certificates MUST be submitted with pre-entries or provided to the Den Steward at the time of judging.
16. Terriers that are competing in the Youth Division, if entered in a regular Go-To-Ground class, MUST compete in their regular class prior to competing in the Youth Handling class.
17. The use of electronic timers at a JRTCA sanctioned trial is acceptable under the guidelines provided. NOTE: If electronic GTG timer is used the following rules apply: a.) The electronic timer is activated when a terrier crosses a beam at the starting end of the GTG tunnel. The starting line is to be set up two feet back from the entrance to the tunnel. When a competing terrier crosses the beam at that starting line, timing will commence. Another beam will be activated 18 inches from the quarry at the end of the tunnel. When the terrier breaks that beam, the electronic clock will be stopped. The electronic timing is then written by the judge on the GTG score sheet. b.) If a terrier does not move directly past the starting line and break the electronic beam when released, the judge should make note on the score sheet of how long a time the terrier spent between its release and when it broke the starting beam. That time should be added to that terrier's time to quarry. c.) All other JRTCA GTG Rules remain unchanged, i.e., those relating to the working performance of the terrier at the quarry.
18. Timing is as follows: Pre-Novice Puppy - One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter until quarry is reached; work quarry for 15 seconds without a break in work and without leaving quarry. Novice Puppy and Novice Adult - One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times until quarry is reached; must work quarry for 30 seconds without a break in work and without leaving quarry. Open Puppy and Open Adult - 1 second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter once until quarry is reached; work quarry for one minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry. Puppy Championship - 1 second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter once until quarry is reached; work quarry for one minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry. Adult Championship Certificate classes - 1 second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may not leave the earth; work quarry for one minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry

Class 102: Pre-novice puppy

Open to Jack Russell puppies 4 up to 6 months. Entry in Pre-Novice Puppy class does not affect the puppy's eligibility to enter the Novice Class after 6 months of age. (One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter until quarry is reached; mark quarry for 15 seconds without a break in work and without leaving quarry. May switch from one type of work to another. Example: baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying)

Class 103: Novice puppy

Open to Jack Russells 6 up to 12 months which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open Puppy Class at this trial. (One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times until quarry is reached; when quarry is reached must work quarry continuously for a full 30 seconds without a break in work and without leaving the quarry; may switch from one type of work to another (examples: baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying.)

Class 104: Novice adult

Open to Jack Russells one year of age or older which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open class at this trial. (One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times until quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for a full 30 seconds without a break in work and without leaving the quarry; may switch from one type of work to another (examples baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying.)

Class 105: Open puppy

Open to Jack Russells 6 up to 12 months who have earned 100% score in a Novice Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. Puppies earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Puppy Championship GTG class at this trial **OR** may continue competing in Open Puppy Go to Ground class at future trials. **Open Puppy GTG is not open to any Puppies which has competed in Puppy Championship GTG.** (One second per foot of tunnel; may leave earth once and re-enter before the quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry; may switch from one type of work to another.)

Class 106: Open adult

Open to Jack Russells one year or older which have scored 100% in a Novice Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. (One second per foot of tunnel; may leave earth once and re-enter before the quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry; may switch from one type of work to another.)

Class 107: Puppy championship

Open to Jack Russells, **6 up to 12 month Puppy Champion Super Earth.** Open to 6 up to 12 month JRT puppies which have earned 100% in an Open 6 up to 12 month Puppy Super Earth Class at this or a previous JRTCA Trial. A copy of a 100% score sheet must be presented with pre-entry or be shown to den steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Puppy Super Earth Champion and Reserve. (One second per foot of tunnel; may leave earth once and re-enter before the quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry; may switch from one type of work to another.)

Class 108: Adult 10 up to 12.5" championship certificate

Open to any adult Jack Russell 10" up to 12.5", one year and over, which holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve. (One second per foot of tunnel; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry. May switch from one type of work to another.)

Class 109: Adult over 12.5" up to 15" championship certificate

Open to any adult Jack Russell over 12.5" up to 15", one year and over, which holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve. (One second per foot of tunnel; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry. May switch from one type of work to another.)

Class 110: Veteran 10 up to 12.5" championship certificate

Open to any adult Jack Russell 10" up to 12.5" 6 years of age or older, who holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. 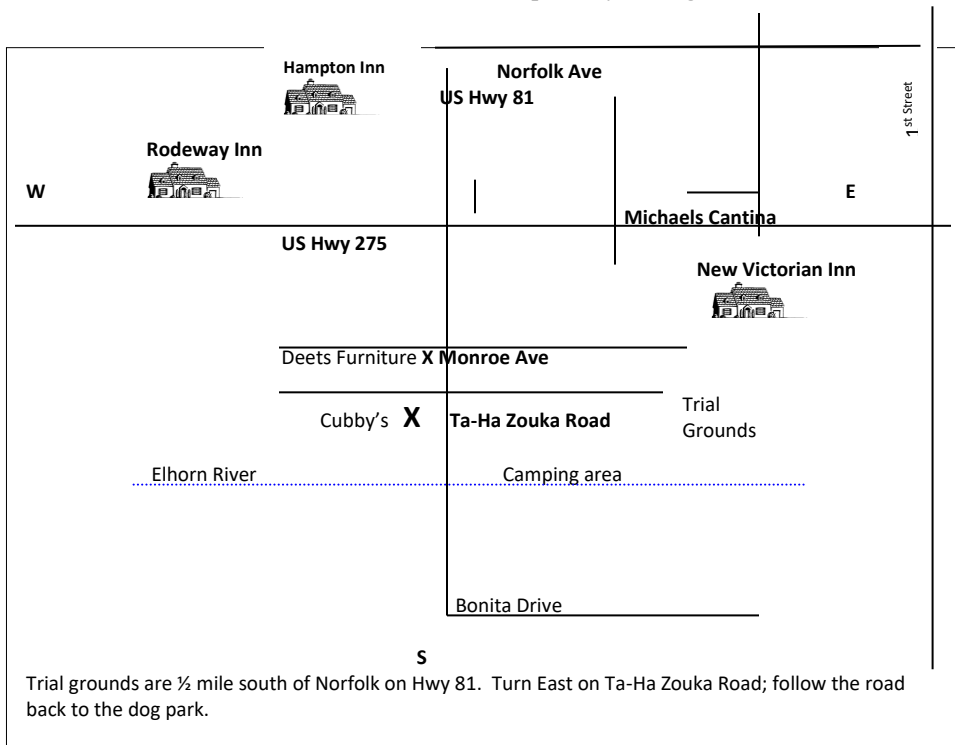
